ALFREDO HÄBERLI of Zurich designed EMPIRE for Quodes. This Argentine-born designer chose basic geometric shapes and piled them one on top of the other to create interesting patterns. Both the variation and the contours give the furniture a fascinating and visual shape. Furniture sculptures, suitable for storing books and exhibiting objects.

Empire has been exhibited in the Museum für Gestaltung in Zürich (Switzerland), in the "Kölnischer Kunstverein" in Cologne (Germany) and has been published a lot around the world.

It is easy to find a space for it and it is extremely practical: books automatically lay on their side, there is no need for book supports anymore!

Empire is very decorative, even more when used in repetition.



Dimensions, colors:

- Height: 200 cm, wide: 45 cm, depth: 35 cm.
- Standard: traffic white (RAL 9016), satin
- Against extra charge: any other satin RAL color is possible. Even most NCS colors can be delivered.

Materials

- MDF, lacquered in satin colours.
- There is a light structure in the lacquer.
- Panels are 17 mm thick.



Construction

- Empire is a technically an extremely challenging product.
- It requires 3D milling equipment with the highest possible precision.
- But most of all, professionals with the best possible craftsmanship realise the delicate assembly and lacquering process.

Delivery, mounting

- We deliver Empire fully mounted in a well developed carton packaging. The carton has the highest possible export quality. For some export destinations, we even add a wooden crate.
- Empire is equipped with adjustable feet, so it is easy to level the cabinet in a perfectly horizontal position.
- Empire can be installed freestanding. Nevertheless, we recommend for security reasons to place Empire against a wall and connect it to the wall.

Maintenance, cleaning

- For the optimal preservation it is important to avoid any contact with sharp, hot or chemical liquids.
- Remove spilled liquids immediately.
- Never use any chemical cleaning liquids and / or abrasives.
- Keep the surfaces clean with a feather duster. If required use a moist cloth or a little bit of soapy water and finish the cleaning with a dry cloth.
- A constant temperature and humidity of the air are important factors for the preservation.
